## Assignments 5/23 - 5/25

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA

Students will review types of sentences.

### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA

Students will be looking at models of government throughout the world.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Math
